## Neighborhood Watch Program

We are now participating in the Neighborhood Watch Program sponsored by the Fishers Police Department. You should have received information from your designated block captain. To receive notifications regarding our neighborhood, please email your full name, address, lot number (if known), and phone number to the email address listed above. Your email address will only be used to communicate with you about neighborhood alerts.

Please follow the tips below from the Fishers PD to assist in keeping our community a

safe place to live:

- Turn on your outside lights at night. Make sure that your dusk to dawn yard light is working properly. Use compact fluorescent bulbs; they put out more light, last longer and cost less to operate.
- Know your neighbors. Trade cell phone numbers with your neighbors in all directions and communicate with them about neighborhood activity.
- Be alert. Call the police when you see suspicious activity. Do not hesitate to call, they depend on you to be their eyes and ears in the neighborhood.

- Notify the neighborhood watch after you have contacted the police.
- Use deadbolts to lock doors and quality locks on windows.
- Lock all vehicles parked outside and close your garage door whether you are home or away. Do not leave your garage door opener in your parked car.
