Entrances Under Construction

Some of the Fishers Farm residents have contacted the Board about the work being done on the entrances to the community. The previous Board had begun the process of refinishing our entrances. Specifically, the brick needed repair so the decision was made at this time to remove the stucco and update the sign fronts. The sign fronts have been completed and can be viewed on our website:

The brick repair work is estimated to take about one month. As soon as that work is done, the signs will be hung. If you are new to the neighborhood and need information, please call Jenifer at 770-8284.

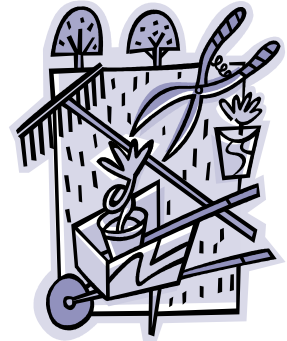
CRIME WATCH
