necessary. If you are new to the neighborhood and need information, please call Jenifer at 770-8284.

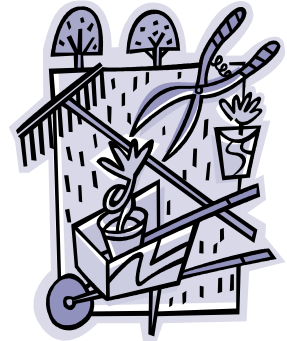
CRIME WATCH
